

**COACHELLA VALLEY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS  
NOTICE OF INTENTION  
TO AMEND THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Executive Committee of the Coachella Valley Association Governments (the "CVAG") intends to amend CVAG's Conflict of Interest Code ("Code") pursuant to Government Code sections 87306 and 87307.

The Appendix of the Code designates those employees, members, officers, and consultants who make or participate in the making of decisions and are subject to the disclosure requirements of CVAG's Code. CVAG's proposed amendment adds new positions that must be designated, deletes positions not required to be designated, revises disclosure categories, formally adopts the standard code and updates language to that currently used by the Fair Political Practices Commission.

A written comment period is hereby established commencing on August 6, 2019, and terminating on September 20, 2019, thereby providing 45 days for comment as required by 2 Cal Code Regs §18750. Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed amended Code no later than September 20, 2019, Joanna Stueckle, Executive Assistant, Coachella Valley Association of Governments, 73710 Fred Waring Dr., Suite 200, Palm Springs, CA 92260. No public hearing on this matter will be held unless an interested person or his or her representative requests a public hearing at least 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period.

CVAG has prepared a written explanation of the reasons for the designations and the disclosure responsibilities and has available all of the information upon which its proposal is based.
