ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

As part of the recruitment process, CVAG is asking applicants to briefly answer the following five questions. The five answers should not exceed two pages, using standard font sizes and page margins. The answers should be submitted with the required application and resume.

1. CVAG works on a variety of transportation projects that are funded with federal, state and local funds. Please describe your familiarity in working with Caltrans Local Assistance staff on federal and state funded transportation projects.
2. CVAG manages a variety of transportation programs, some of which include Active Transportation, Signal Synchronization and Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety. Tell us about your experience in managing these types of programs, or similar ones, and how you believe it will contribute to CVAG.
3. The Transportation Engineer will be involved in multiple projects at the same time. Describe how you manage your time on a daily or weekly basis, particularly in situations where you may have pressing deadlines and must multitask.
4. Based on your experience, what is the most important skill a Transportation Engineer must have to succeed? Explain why this skill is critical to effective project management and how it will benefit CVAG.
5. As a Transportation Engineer, you will be relied upon for your professional opinion on transportation projects. Provide an example of when your professional opinion was valuable on a project and why?
